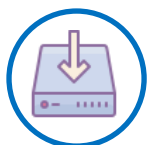

HTML—A programming language to use on web pages



HTML Tags— A command to produce content on a web page



Code— A system of words or letters to program instructions



Text— A piece of writing



CSS— Used to format the layout of web pages



Appearance— The way something looks



Pixels— A minute area of illumination on a screen where an image is formed



Webpage— A document connected to the world wide web



Inspect Elements Tool— See what a web page consists of in terms of code



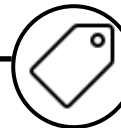
Fake News— Stories that appear to be true but aren't

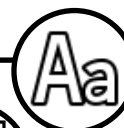
