End of KS2 Assessment information summary 2022 - 2023

At SJS, **48.3%** of pupils reached the new expected standards in **RWM combined**

Each pupil's raw test score has been converted into a score on a scale, either **at, above or below 100**. A scaled score of 100 represents the '**national standard**'. A child who achieves the 'national standard' (a score of 100 or more) is judged to have demonstrated sufficient knowledge in the areas assessed by the tests. A child awarded a scaled score of less than 100 is judged to have not yet met the national standard and performed below expectation for their age.

National averages for the 'scaled-scores' have also been published. These are as follows;
