End of KS2 Assessment information summary 2021 - 2022

At SJS, **73%** of pupils reached the new expected standards in **RWM combined**

Subject attainment – Expected Standard

Subject attainment – Higher Standard

SJS achieved higher than the National Average for children achieving the expected standard and the higher standard in Reading, Writing and Maths (RWM) combined.

Each pupil's raw test score has been converted into a score on a scale, either **at, above or below** 100. A scaled score of 100 represents the '**national standard**'. A child who achieves the 'national standard' (a score of 100 or more) is judged to have demonstrated sufficient knowledge in the areas assessed by the tests. A child awarded a scaled score of less than 100 is judged to have not yet met the national standard and performed below expectation for their age.

National averages for the 'scaled-scores' have also been published. These are as follows;
