This Policy runs alongside the Aspire MAT School Uniform Policy. The information within this Appendix outlines the uniform children are required to wear at Sir John Sherbrooke Junior School.

Children must wear the correct uniform to school. This does not have to have the SJS logo on as we appreciate there will be additional cost involved. However, we do encourage children to wear at least a jumper/cardigan with the SJS logo on if possible which can be ordered from:

There are also frequent times within the school year when clean, second-hand uniform is available for anyone to reuse.

Hats, Headscarves or Headwear

Pupils are not allowed to wear hats, headscarves, or any other head covering inside the school building unless it is due to religious or cultural reasons. Any head covering for religious or cultural values or hair accessories that are worn such as slides, ribbons, bobbles etc. should be simple and in school colours. No oversized bows or fancy-dress headbands should be worn in school.

Hairstyles

Pupils' hair should be neatly groomed and professional at all times. Pupils may not wear designs or words cut into their hair or permanent or temporary coloured hair at school. All long hair, if touching the shoulders or beyond, for both boys and girls must be tied up.

Nail Polish, False Nails or Make-Up

Please do not send your child to school wearing nail polish, false nails or make-up. Parents will be called into school to remove these or the child asked to wash it off their face.

Jewellery/Accessories

Pupils may wear a watch, without internet, messaging or camera access, and one pair of stud earrings worn in the lower ear lobe. For safety reasons all studs must be removed for PE or taped. No other jewellery must be worn, including bracelets and necklaces, unless for religious reasons agreed with school. *Please note that the school will be unable to take any responsibility for any watches or jewellery that are lost.*

Footwear

Pupils must wear closed-toed, hard-soled, **all black** plain shoes with a flat sole. Footwear with flashing lights is not appropriate for school. Boots are not allowed unless for medical purposes. For health and safety reasons, open-toed sandals should not be worn, even in the summer. Trainers must only be worn for PE, not as general school shoes.

Naming Clothing and Property

VERY IMPORTANT – Please ensure all clothing and property is clearly marked so that lost articles may be easily traced and returned. The school cannot accept responsibility for loss or damage of pupils' property and valuables.

All mislaid items are placed in the lost property box. We endeavor to return all named property. Unnamed lost property will be washed and put out for parents to re-use.

SIR JOHN SHERBROOKE JUNIOR SCHOOL UNIFORM DETAILS

Please note, no items of clothing should have logos other than the SJS logo.

Year 3/4

- **Navy/black skirt or trousers**
- Navy school sweatshirt or cardigan with school logo
- Pale blue polo t-shirt
- Black school shoes
- Black/navy/grey socks or tights

Year 5/6

- **Navy/black skirt or trousers**
- Navy school sweatshirt or cardigan with school logo
- Pale blue button-down shirt
- School tie (the first one will be provided by school, if lost/damaged, parents must pay to replace it)
- Black school shoes
- Black/navy/grey socks or tights

PE – Whole school

- Navy shorts
 - Pale blue logo t-shirt
 - Trainers
 - For cold weather - navy sweatshirt or school jumper can be worn
 - School logoed hoodie can be worn for PE only
 - Navy/Dark Blue or Black joggers or leggings can be worn in cold weather
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- Our SJS uniform is 'all year round' uniform, with it being down to parents/carers when it is appropriate to wear jumpers or warm weather dresses. SJS require adults to ensure uniform is appropriate for the weather.
 - All children should wear school uniform. SJS branded tops are encouraged, but not expected, as long as the clothing is the same colour and style as the branded uniform. No other brands should be worn.
 - SJS PE uniform should be worn, with school jumpers being used during colder weather. Dark blue or black jogging bottoms or leggings are allowed during colder weather. Branded PE tops are encouraged, but non-branded tops of the same colour and style can be used. Normal trainers can be worn. General sports or leisure wear should not be worn.
 - We encourage uniform to be bought from the uniform shops, which sell the SJS branded items, however non-branded uniform that is of the same colour and style can be bought from any other establishment.

Our uniform has been kept simple to avoid unnecessary expense. All the items are readily available from the high street – if parents/carers find any item difficult to obtain, please contact the school.
