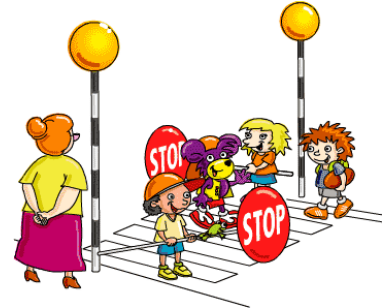
What is child protection about?

At SJS, all the adults around you think that your health, safety, and welfare are very important. In our school we respect our children and want to keep you safe and help to protect your rights. We do our best to help you to make good progress in your school work and to be happy. We teach you how to recognise risks in different situations and how to protect yourselves and stay safe.



Ways We Help to Keep You Safe

- We provide a safe environment for you to learn in.
- We want to ensure that you remain safe at home as well as at school.
- We teach you how to be safe and how to recognise risks.
- We think it is important for you to know where to get help if you are worried or unhappy about something.



If you need to talk – we will listen!

- You can talk to any adult in school.
- It is Mrs Mee's special job to keep you safe – you can always talk to her if you are worried
- Put something in the worry box in your classroom
- Tell a friend and then go with your friend to tell an adult

Don't keep it a secret if someone is:

- Bullying you;
- Saying funny things to you that you do not like or which upsets you;
- Touching you;
- Trying to give you tablets, cigarettes, drugs or alcohol;
- Hitting you or hurting you;
- Taking your things;
- Sending unkind messages on the internet or to your phone.



Remember: You can talk to us about **anything** that is worrying you, whether it's happening in school or away from school and whether it's about you or someone else.
